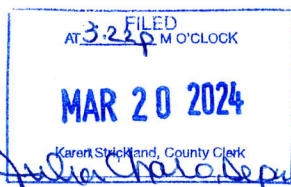

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE


1. Call meeting to order
