WHEREAS, the County of Lynn on the 29th of May, 2024, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from

Severe Weather, Straight line winds (excess of 100 MPH) has severely damaged homes, agriculture, businesses, and infrastructure.

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Lynn County] has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF Lynn County]:
That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for LYNN COUNTY pursuant to §418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the COMMISSIONERS COURT of LYNN COUNTY.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the COUNTY CLERK.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the LYNN COUNTY emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
