ORDER PROHIBITING CERTAIN FIREWORKS IN SPECIFIED AREAS OF LYNN COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, on the 23rd of January, 2023, the Commissioners Court of Lynn County has determined that conditions on certain uncultivated acreage in the are extremely hazardous for the danger of fire because of high grass of dry vegetation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE Commissioners Court of Lynn County adopts this Order prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the following areas of Lynn County: within a ½ mile of

A. PASTURES, CRP, GRASSY AND COVER CROP AREAS


B. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as “skyrockets with sticks” under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2)(10-1-86 edition) or missiles with fins in these specified areas of Lynn County.

C. This Order does not prohibit “permissible fireworks” as authorized in Occupational Code Section 2154.003(a).

D. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a class C. Misdemeanor.

E. This order expires on February 2, 2023.
