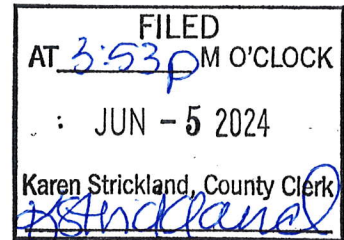


The Lynn County Commissioner's Court will meet in regular session on **Monday June 10, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. at 1501 South 1st Street**
